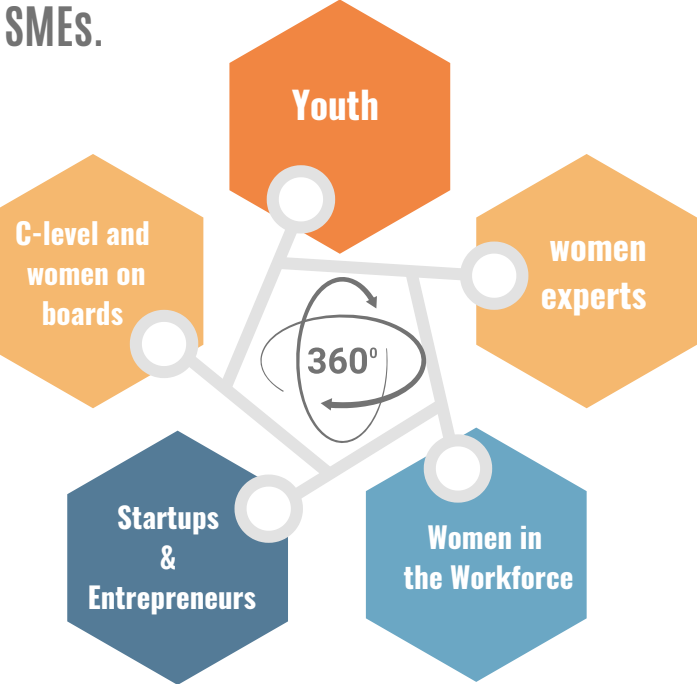


WHY JOIN LLWB?
